## *idea 1* the inspiration

Designing a room and don't know where to start? The easiest way is to find something inspirational and design the scheme around it. In the case of this bedroom, old map cushions provided the theme and colour palette for the room. To reflect the bygone era suggested by the cushions, dark timbers and traditional tones were used to complement the scheme.

{ A mosquito net draped over a bed provides a serene and enticing feel to any bedroom.

## *idea 2* keep it simple

If using a cushion or other item that you want to focus on don't cramp it and deflect attention away from it. Rather, keep everything around simple to give it maximum exposure. In this case we chose to highlight the cushions by using crisp white bedding, understated bedside tables and lamps and a delicate mosquito net, just to add a touch of romance.
